Christianity	Religion based on the person and teachings of Jesus Christ.
Christian	A person who believes in Jesus Christ and follows the religion Christianity.
Faith	Complete trust or confidence in someone or something.
Beliefs	An acceptance that something exists or is true, especially one without proof.
Ascension	The action of rising to an important position or a higher level.
Empowerment	Authority or power given to someone to do something.
Pentecost	The Christian festival celebrating the descent of the Holy Spirit on the disciples of Jesus after his Ascension, held on the seventh Sunday after Easter.
Holy Spirit	The third person of the Trinity; God as spiritually active in the world.
Missionary	A person sent on a religious mission, especially one sent to promote Christianity in a foreign country.
Pilgrimage	A pilgrim's journey.
Worship	Used in addressing or referring to an important or high-ranking person
Evolution	The process by which different kinds of living organism are believed to have developed from earlier forms during the history of the earth.
Trinity	The three persons of the Christian Godhead; Father, Son, and Holy Spirit.

Sequence for learning	
1.	(W.A.L.T) explaining how individuals show their faith. You will have the opportunity to explore the ways people express their beliefs and create a poster to display these.
2.	(W.A.L.T) discuss individual's ideas of the answers to ultimate questions. You will have the opportunity to explore the ultimate questions and express your own ideas regarding the answers.
3.	(W.A.L.T) explore the difference between my answers and the ideas of others. You will have the opportunity to explore Christians' answers to the ultimate questions.
4.	(W.A.L.T) to learn the events of Jesus' Ascension and how Christians now spread the message of God. You will have the opportunity to explore the events of Jesus' Ascension how this wasn't the end of Jesus' influence however part of His legacy was to task His apostles with the responsibility of continuing His work here.
5.	(W.A.L.T) making links between the events of the empowerment of Christians to spread the Christian message and the first Pentecost. You will explore the events of the first Pentecost and how the Holy Spirit would be with the disciples and would help them and empower them to continue to spread Jesus' message and undertake His ministry on Earth.
6.	(W.A.L.T) to explain the reason religious sources have helped to keep the Christian message alive for over 2,000 years. You will be shown the 2012 Olympic torch relay and you will explore the message spread by this event and how it relates to the way the Christian message has been spread.
